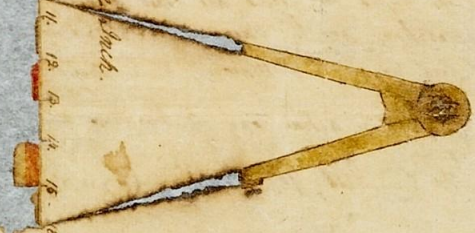

 George Burdick Junr 1st 1742
 Moved in a Plan of the Town of
 Dorchester with the names of
 Some of the Present owners inserted
 in the Margin. It is part of a parcel
 of Land granted by the Lords Proprietors
 their Deputies to John Stevens (now
 dead) in the year 1696 in two
 separate Tracts being in the whole
 1050 Acres, which said Land, were
 laid out for the use of a certain Number
 of Families. And by their mutual agreement di-
 vided into Lots of various Quantities, at which
 time the above Represented Place was laid out
 for a Town. by the mutual Consent of all the
 Parties then concerned therein, agreed by to the
 above Plan, and Titles issued to the true Owners of
 said Lot of various Denominations, & Town Lots, according
 to respective numbers, by the above said John Stevens & said
 Place hath ever since been considered as a Place for Trade by
 said John Stevens & his Heirs, & all other Owners therein
 Capable & do hereby Testify the Day & year above written by
 Sam^l Stevens
