To all to whom these Presents shall come
be seen or made known I Christopher Rogers of Charleston in the
State aforesaid send Greeting, Know ye that I the said Christopher
Rogers for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred Pounds -
Sterling to me in hand well and truly paid at or before the Seal-
ing and Delivery of these presents and for divers other good causes and
considerations me thereunto especially moving, have Manumitted

443 enfranchised and set free, and by these presents do manumit enfran-
chise and set free a certain Mulatto Man named Jehu Jones of and
from all manner of bondage and Slavery whatsoever, To have and
to hold such manumission and freedom unto the said Mulatto Man
named Jehu Jones for ever, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal the twenty second day of January in the year of
our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight -
Sealed and Delivered in the presence of Chris. Rogers
of James Donaldson, Alex. Clarkson & Charleston Es.
Personally appeared Mr. Alexander Clarkson who being duly
sworn made oath that he was present and saw Christopher Rogers
sign seal and as his act and deed deliver the within Deed -
for the uses and purposes therein set forth and that he the Deponent
with James Donaldson signed their names as witnesses thereto -
Sworn to the 22^d day of January 1798 before Stephen Ravenel Es.
