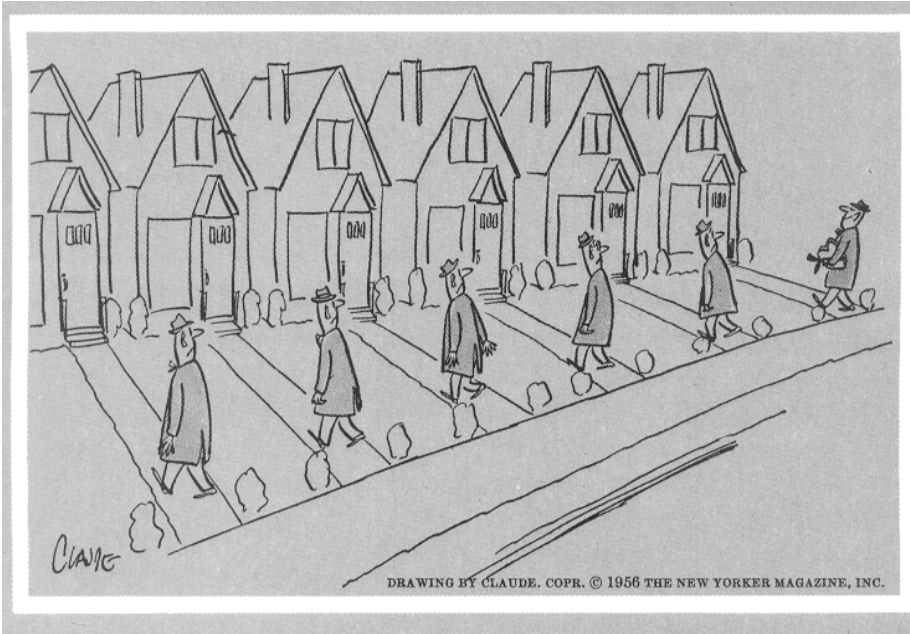


Behind the Picket Fence
