Perspective

1. What points of view are given or left out of the source? Is each viewpoint fairly represented? Patriots point of view was given and not fairly represented.

Audience

2. Who was the source meant for and why? Patriots so they could know how they won the war.

Summary

3. What does this source tell us about the topic? What new questions does it raise? About the battle of cowpens. How many men died?

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4. What historical background do we need to know to understand this source? Battle of cowpens
